Question #1

Tell me about your ability to work under pressure as Financial Controller?

Many consider this question to be a loaded gun - dangerous in the hands of the inexperienced. Do some research into your industry to establish base rates of pay based on seniority and demand but keep in mind - your employer is hiring you for what they believe you are worth, and how much benefit they feel you will provide.

One relatively safe approach is simply asking the interviewer about the salary range. If you wish to avoid the question entirely, respond by saying that "money isn't a key factor" and your primary goal is to advance in your career.

Your interview answer should showcase your comprehensive research and knowledge of the company and how well you understand its achievements, its goals and the challenges it faces. Provide examples of the skills and ideas you bring that would result in a contribution to profits and growth.

Tell me how does this particular role support you?

Answer:-

It's important to understand where the job you're after is located on the company totem pole, and how your role would be linked to that of the individual you'd be reporting to (who in most cases will also be the person interviewing you).

Your prospective supervisor will in all likelihood have their own ideas about how a new hire will make their job easier, so be sure to ask them directly about how they



see you supporting them. Plus, you'll likely earn bonus points by exhibiting an appropriate level of deference.

Question # 29

Tell me what deliverables should I shoot for in the first 30, 60 and 90 days, respectively?

A prospective employer or hiring manager will typically use the interview to give a broad idea both of what the position entails, and of what skills, qualities, and personality they're looking for in a successful candidate.

But interviewers tend to be cover about how precisely a new hire's performance will be evaluated in the early-going - that is, what specific, concrete benchmarks they'll need to reach in order to meet expectations and survive beyond the probationary period.

Question # 30

Tell us I don't expect you to go into too much detail - but why are you leaving your last job?

Answer:-

An innocent question. But a question that if answered improperly, can be a deal breaker. While many individuals will be looking to a new job as a means of increasing their salary, "not being paid well enough at your last job" is not something you want to mention to your interviewer. After all, are you not likely to leave this particular job if you found you could make more down the street?

If you're currently employed and leaving of your own accord, craft your response around enhancing your career development and a seeking out of new challenges. If your current employer is downsizing, be honest about it, remain positive, but keep it brief. If your employer fired you or let you go for cause, be prepared to give a brief - but honest - reply. No matter how tempting it may be, or how "unfair it was that they let you go" steer clear away from any and all drama and negativity. Any experienced employer understands that sometimes things happen. Staying positive is key here.

Answer:-

This can be a great way to stand out from other applicants and demonstrate initiative. Almost every company will have a website, Facebook page, Instagram account, or some sort of digital footprint. Spend a bit of time doing some online research:

- * If they have a website, check out their "About us" or "Culture/Mission/Vision" pages.

 * Who are some of the principal people who work there? Who are the founders?
- * What sorts of things does this company care about? Do they donate to a particular cause or charity? Which one(s)?
- * What are their core values? Which of their core values resonate with you?
- * Has the company been in the news recently or have they won any awards (Social Media can be a great place to find this information).

Finance jobs demand the ability to work well under pressure. The interviewer wants to know whether you are able to perform under stress and cope with difficult situations. Show that you can stay calm and are able to plan to reduce stress.

Question # 36

Why Did You Quit a Given Job as Financial Controller?



Answer:-

If the interviewer asks about why you quit a certain job, or why there are gaps in your resume, what should you say? This short video addresses that difficult question. However, presenting your reasons awkwardly or unconvincingly definitely is bound to raise questions about you and damage your chances. Be sure that you rehearse your explanations in accordance with these suggestions.

You want to be paid as much as you can, while the hiring firm wants to get your services for as little as they can. Do not undersell yourself and your abilities, but do not make your demands so high that that you are rejected out of hand as a potential hire if you would settle for less.
